



# UMW News

### Our Women in December

Our busy month began with Ingathering on Dec. 7th, the year end meeting where we collect a special offering in thanks for the season and the abundance we enjoy. I think it is important to note that we took in \$3200, which has been distributed in the set amounts and percentages that are published in our yearbook. A.I.M. received \$400, House By the Side of the Road, \$500, S.A.F.E Place, \$300, Women United, \$100, Grand Rapids Community House, \$100, and the Chelsea Retirement Benevolent Care Fund. \$100. The Baby Pantry received

\$360 (20%), S.I.S., \$360 (20%), Healthy Babies Day, \$539 (30%) and Vision of Life \$539 (30%). So, our UMW supports local missions.

Other year-end financial notes: we completed our general pledge to mission goal of \$2500, and in addition supported the Women's Division through our giving to Special Mission Recognition ,\$80; Gift to Mission and Gift in Memory, \$40; World Thank Offering, \$168; Prayer and Self-Denial, \$31; and contributions to the Legacy Fund (which celebrates 150 years of UMW) \$1650. Through these gifts we support our world missions.

We hosted 35 people on Dec. 13th for an advent luncheon, and enjoyed seeing Gwen and Shelly Bagley on the 21st at our joint Circle Meeting. Gwen gave the program on her recent trip to Nicaragua, and brought us up to date with her career hopes and dreams. It's hard to believe that the last time most of us saw her she was 11 years old! She hopes to continue in the mission field, and was a gratifying witness to the influence that UMW has had on her life.

Starting in November and finishing the second week in December, we once again made peanut brittle. With sales not yet completed, the project has earned \$752, and the making

of it again offered the candy makers plenty of fellowship time in our beautiful kitchen.

There will be an Epiphany meeting at Marshall UMC on Jan. 13, 2018, from 10 am to 2 pm. The cost, which includes lunch, is \$10. Please contact the church office to make a reservation.
