## Church Finances Impacted, but Holding On

The effects of months of disrupted schedules and economic uncertainty is impacting all of us. The church is no exception. But, thanks to your continued faithful giving and a little outside help, there's no cause for concern.

Through the first half of 2020, the church received a little more than \$82,000 in pledged and non-pledged giving. That's a remarkable total, given that we were together for just 12 of the 26 Sundays in those months. It is, however, more than \$10,000 below what was expected.

Thankfully, the disruption in "normal" church operations has also meant lower expenditures than budgeted. Costs have run approximately \$16,000 below expectations and the church has continued to pay all staff thanks to the Paycheck Protection Program loan received in April. (note that we are currently completing the required application to have this loan forgiven under the provisions of the federal law.)

The upshot of all these numbers is that the church is holding on through these unprecedented times thanks to your continued generosity and the stewardship of our financial leaders. While we are apart, please continue to drop your pledge checks in the mail or the mailbox inside the Oswego Street doors. Your faithfulness is greatly appreciated.
