"... one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray ..." (Luke 11:1)

Recently, I heard a clergy colleague talking about the power that prayer has to transform our lives. "The transcript of your prayers," he said, "will become the script of your future." I found myself wondering if I pray expecting that kind of impact. Do I expect to encounter God in such a profound way? Do you?

Rev. James Harnish, in a reflection about prayer for the "A Disciple's Path," shares a story about a congregation of "teetotaling Methodists" who prayed fervently for the Lord to do something about the disreputable bar across the street from the church. The bar was hit by lightning and burned to the ground. The bar owner promptly sued the church, claiming the congregation's prayers were responsible. The church contested the suit. After hearing the case, the judge said, 'I'm not sure how I'll rule on this case, but one thing is clear. The bar owner believes in prayer, and the church people don't."

There has been much to pray for recently in the life of our church. Grief, pain, uncertainty and fear are all too common human experiences. As you continue to pray for one another, my prayer for you is that you will feel God's presence in those moments of communion and that you will be changed by the encounter.

Albion FUMC May Be Short-Term Preschool Location

The Battle Creek YMCA currently operates a Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP) preschool in Battle Creek in partnership with the Calhoun County Intermediate School District. GSRP is a pre-K readiness program for at-risk kids to prepare them for kindergarten. (Learn more about it here: MDE - Great Start Readiness Program (michigan.gov))



The YMCA has been approved for a similar program here in Albion for up to 32 children and were planning to operate at Crowell School until the program can move into the new Y, once it is built. A significant lead paint problem has been discovered and that location has been ruled out.

Inspections have been completed and some of our under-utilized space on the 2nd floor meets state guidelines for this program. The Trustees will soon decide if we will move forward with this program.

Albion's Food Distribution Program Gets a New Name and New Location

The ad-hoc group that came together to help meet emergency needs in the early days of the pandemic continues to provide leadership for Albion's food distribution program. Pastor Leslee has been an active part of this group. To ensure this critical work continues and expands, the group has decided to organize into a more formal operation.

The Community Table of Albion (CTA) is the new name of this partnership of local groups and individuals working together to combat food insecurity in our community. The name change reflects the inclusive nature of the food distribution outreach service. All are welcome at the table.

Beginning in May, the Community Table of Albion will operate from Kresge Commons behind Wesley Hall. The new location was donated by Albion College and allows for more space and better coordination. The college renovated the larger distribution space and donated significant time, materials and labor. Local resident Bill Dobbins also assisted with the renovation effort.


The thrice-monthly food distributions will continue on the 2nd, 3rd and 4th Tuesday of each month beginning at 4pm. The first distribution at the new location is May 11.

Plans are also developing for an on-going Food Pantry at this location.
