



### Scouts BSA, Troop 158 Annual Holiday Evergreens Sale


It's that time of year again! Troop 158 BSA is holding our annual Holiday Evergreens

### **UMW Update**

A group of us met on October 9 to discuss the future of our UMW unit, in light of our declining membership and the restrictions on group gatherings due to COVID. It was decided that the Circle

Programs that had to be cancelled this year (there were 3) would be moved to next year, for the same months with all meetings being held at the church and in compliance with current health guidelines. Donna Williams and Anne Lake volunteered to take leadership roles. Alice Cook will continue as Treasurer. The yearbook was discussed. While not willing to discontinue it entirely, it was decided that Polly and Cindi, church Office Manager, would work to create a more directory-like format that would require minimal updating for a five-year period. It is hoped that other information such as meeting times, special projects, etc. will be shared in the Spire.

**Ingathering** will occur during a regular church service in November or December; the date is yet to be determined.

Polly will organize the **Peanut Brittle Project** in November. Donations of sugar and butter from the congregation are welcomed, and can be dropped off anytime in the church kitchen.

**Piecemakers** could continue if there is leadership interest forthcoming.
