The annual business meeting of the church took place on Wednesday,

September 23 with our new District Superintendent, LuAnn Rourke, via Zoom. This meeting, which is required by church rules, enables congregation members to participate in decision-making for the church.

At the church conference, participants:

- reviewed the membership list, voting to remove 4 individuals who are no longer involved in the life of the church
- approved the compensation package for Pastor Leslee for 2021
- approved the lay leadership report, detailing committee assignments and leadership roles
- affirmed the church's recommendation of Lois Fennimore to continue as a Certified Lay Servant, Certified Lay Speaker and Certified Lay Minister

Since the Michigan BSA is licensed thru the state's DHS youth division, all youth summer camps were closed. A few of our scouts attended Camp-Sort-Of. This was a Virtual Summer Camp experience to substitute for in person camping. The scouts were able to work towards rank advancement and earn some merit badges.

Beginning July 1st, we were permitted to meet in person under strict 5-Step restarting scout procedures and regulations which are all in line with the Governor's executive orders. # Wesley Renovation conversation continues

The task force created by the Church Council last winter to consider options for renovating Wesley Chapel and Wesley Lounge has continued it's work this summer. The group has largely completed its first task which was to identify our shared priorities for any potential project. Among the priorities identified are:

- Address any structural issues that may exist
- Create a more visible and welcoming entrance
- Update and make restrooms accessible
- Create more flexible chancel space for worship

- Update sanctuary technology to improve sound, video and recording/broadcasting capabilities
- Identify or create more useable storage areas, including for coats
- Address the narrow, steep balcony stairs
- Update and reconfigure gathering area to create a lively space which encourages interaction, conversation and small group activity

The next steps are to engage with professionals to determine the options for addressing these priorities. These conversations will soon begin and should result in some initial plans and cost estimates. At that point, we will hold a church meeting for input and discussion. This will be the first of several church meetings throughout the process. If you have questions or concerns about the group's work or the potential project, Pastor Leslee is always happy to talk.
