#### **Some Updates**

Greetings all -

Ministry in this day and age requires a great deal of flexibility and nimbleness. The world is changing at a fast pace, and we have to adjust sometimes. Sometimes these adjustments are hard, like the changes we've had to make around Covid. But sometimes, there is the opportunity for new ventures, such as our renovation project. So I wanted to give you some updates on where we stand in this new year on a couple of fronts.

**Covid:** Right now, we hope to be back for inperson worship by February 13, 2022. I know this has been a hard time when we couldn't be in person. I have felt this personally as first we needed to isolate at Michael tested positive for Covid, and now we have to quarantine our son Samuel who is considered exposed. Wesley Chapel Renovation: This month, the Church Council voted to approve repaving the driveway underneath our arch, and contract with Driven Design architects to work on the entrance and bathrooms for Wesley. That work is progressing and we are awaiting preliminary ideas. We hope to create at least two handicap accessible bathrooms, create a coat area near the entrance, and adjust our food service capabilities.

We are continuing to look at refurbishing our pews, making our chancel area handicap accessible, making the archway more inviting, improving audio/ visual capabilities of the chapel, improving windows, and improvements
